1527 S. Mayhill Rd., 7 a.m.-4 p.m., Mon.-Sat. Add-on and landfill service fees may apply. For the resident rate, show proof of residency at the gate using your current utility bill.



Trash Collection

Trash bags not in the cart or overflowing are charged \$5 per bag. Includes, but is not limited to, plastic bags, plastic wrap, styrofoam, food waste, paper plates, napkins, tissues, paper towels, clothing, juice pouches, and plastic utensils.







Recycle Collection

Keep recyclables empty, clean, dry, and un-bagged. Recycle only metal cans, glass bottles, plastic bottles, glass jars, tubs, jugs, cartons, junk mail, magazines, newspaper, and flattened cardboard and boxboard.

Yard Waste Collection

Place loose in the cart or kraft bag. Includes grass clippings, leaves, weeds, loose coffee grounds, uncooked fruits & vegetables. Do not place yard waste in plastic bags.

Brush Collection

Brush & tree limbs need to be cut 4 ft to 8 ft in length and stacked into a pile that is less than 4 cubic yards, to avoid additional fees.

Bulk Waste Collection | To schedule a pick-up, complete the online form. Only two items per week; add-on fee may apply. Bulk items will only be collected at the curb if they are pre-scheduled. If your pick-up is more than you requested, we will apply the Residential Remodeling Rate to your request, not the Bulk Waste Collection Rate.

Appliances & Electronics | To schedule a pick-up, complete the online form. Appliances & electronics cannot be collected as bulk waste due to harmful components that must be removed prior to refuse and recycling; a \$20 per item fee may apply.

Home Chemical Collection | To schedule a pick-up, complete the online form. Examples include batteries, lightbulbs, paint, and motor oil. For a full list of HCC items we accept, visit www.cityofdenton.com/hcc. Drive-thru drop off is located at 1527 S. Mayhill Rd.

Water and Wastewater Rates

Base rates help recover the cost of providing services. The basic principle for fixed rates is to ensure we provide equitable services that are not related to how much water you use. Since there is no meter on your wastewater line, the City uses a winter average because outdoor water demand is typically low December through February.

Drainage Rate

The Drainage Rate serves to recover the cost of storm water management as it relates to the flooding, erosion and water pollution based on runoff characteristics, not property value.
